

Kelvin Grove Changing Places

Case Study



Changing Places are facilities designed to improve access, not restrict use, for people with a disability, alleviating the difficulty faced in finding accessible facilities that are open after hours. For the first Changing Places facility in the Melbourne council area of Darebin, record Automatic Doors was engaged to supply and install an STA 20 automatic sliding door operator along with the accessible privacy kit to provide a secure facility for users, and let people outside know when it is being occupied. Access is only available to eligible carers with an MLAK key.
